Overview

This programme is designed to prepare experienced manufacturing personnel for management positions. Learners will gain understanding of Total Productive Management, experience in the tools and techniques of continuous improvement, they will develop their people management skills and expand their big picture understanding of the end-to-end business supply chain.

Participant Profile

Production managers responsible for multiple lines and shifts, and people with the short term potential for promotion to that level.

Duration

Learners spend a total of 26 days in the classroom over a period of 12 months.

Learning & Assessment

Every module is followed by some kind of practical project but the feature of this learnership is a three phase continuous improvement project implemented over a period of four months.

Phase 1 (Improvement Plan): Learners are expected to identify an improvement opportunity, formulate objectives, generate an action plan and devise visuals to track performance against objectives.

Phase 2 (Implementation): Learners are expected to work with their team (and possibly other departments) to implement the plan over a period of three months.

Phase 3 (Report back to management): Learners are expected to make a formal presentation to their management team detailing the original improvement objective, the improvements they have achieved and the impact on plant efficiencies.



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
